Self-study and activation of the learner

On behalf of the SILVA Network, the Estonian University of Life Sciences, Institute of Forestry and Rural Engineering will host a conference on Forestry Education. The conference is again co-organized by the IUFRO education group.

The excursion will head to the Järvselja Forest Experimental Center which is located in the south-east of the country and close to the lake Pihkva (45 km from Tartu). For participants who want to return to Tartu earlier (17:30 o'clock) a separate transport can be organized.

Topic and call for contributions

The focus of the conference in forest science education is aimed at self-study and activation of the learner. Participants are encouraged to prepare a presentation in closer or wider connection with the theme of the conference. Student and IFSA participation is encouraged.

Please send by E-mail an abstract of up to 300 words to M. Ziesak (martin.ziesak@bfh.ch) till **June 30th, 2016**. The committee will decide on contributions and all applicants will be informed as soon as possible.

<u>Fees</u>

The regular participation fee is $170 \in$ (special fees for students: $100 \in$) which must be **paid** in **cash** at the registration. This fee includes coffee breaks, 3 lunches, a conference dinner and the field trip.

Accommodation

Participants have to make their accommodation arrangements themselves, at own cost. We suggest the hotel "Dorpat" (<u>http://www.dorpat.ee/</u>) which is 100 m from the Tartu terminal bus station. Transport between hotel "Dorpat" and the Institute will be organized.

Travel arrangements

Participants have to make their travel arrangements themselves, at own cost. Tartu is located 186 km from Tallinn. There exist two major travel options for reaching Tartu:

Fly to Tallinn and use the bus connection between Tallinn (airport) and Tartu, operating twice per hour. For details and tickets see: <u>http://www.tpilet.ee/en</u>

The other option is to fly via Helsinki directly to Tartu (TAY) with the flight numbers AY 119 (inbound) respectively AY 120. The transfer from Tartu airport to the recommended Dorpat hotel will need only 15 minutes.

All meetings will be held in the "Forestry building" (METSAMAJA), Kreutzwaldi 5, Institute of Forestry and Rural Engineering.
